Dear Grade 2 Students,


This week we are learning about what we can do to help the Earth. What are some things you see in our world that is harming our Earth? What have you seen or heard that has helped the Earth?

Spelling Activity Choices:

- 1. Chalk Talk: Write your spelling words outside using sidewalk chalk.
- 2. <u>Hidden Picture</u>: Draw and colour an outdoor scene. Remember to add great details and lots of colour. Then, hide your spelling words somewhere inside the picture.
- 3. <u>Fish Words</u>: Draw a fish for each of your spelling words. Write one spelling word inside each fish. Then, colour your fish.
- 4. **Earth Day Story**: Write an Earth Day story using your spelling words. Be sure to include interesting details and underline your spelling words in the story.
- 5. <u>Jumping Jacks</u>! Write a spelling word on your paper. Then, complete one jumping jack for every letter in the word and one more to say the word. Repeat for all of your spelling words.
- 6. **Speed Writing**: Write your spelling words as many times as you can in **10 MINUTES!** Ask an adult at home to help you keep track of time.
- 7. <u>Bubble Letters</u>: Write each of your spelling words <u>two times</u> using **Bubble Letters**.
- 8. <u>3 Times Each</u>: Write each of your spelling words <u>three times each</u>. Then, circle all of the <u>vowels</u>
- 9. **Practice Test**: Ask an adult at home to quiz you on your spelling words. If you misspell a word, write it correctly three more times.
