April 7, 2020 – Daily Report

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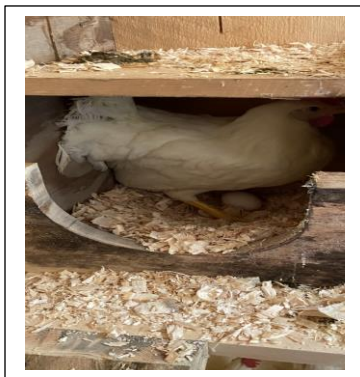


Mrs. Haidner

To make it easier with creating PDF files, I have not created all the boxes around each activity or task. I know it looks nicer, but for ease of sending you the information it will look a little different.

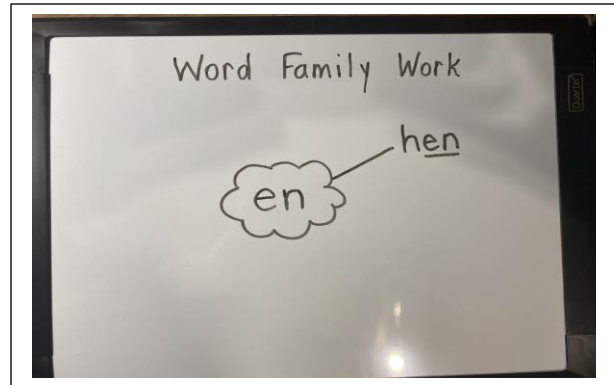
You will never guess what happened last night!

Repeating by 1's

Repeating by 3's

- 3
- $3 + 3 = ?$
- $3 + 3 + 3 = ?$

- Re-create the number patterns above.
- For repeating patterns 2 and 3, be sure to do all 10 repeating addition questions like in the repeating by 1's example.
- Keep your work in a safe spot as you will need it again later this week.
